The Spring Rally 12 Car – Navigational Rally
29 March 2019

The Dolphin Motor Club will organise a Clubman's Permit 12 Car Navigation Rally, on Friday 29th March 2019, starting and finishing at the Pelican Public House in Froxfield. GR 174/ 303¹/₄ 679¹/₂

1. MSA Permit No:- TBA
2. The event is open to all members of the organising club, Oxford Motor Club, Basingstoke Motor Club, Devizes MC, Farnborough District Motor Club, BAMA, Guildford MC, Hants & Berks MC, Thame MC, OUMF, Salisbury & Shaftesbury CC, Southsea Motor Club, Witney MC & Windsor Motor Club.
3. All competitors must produce a valid club card.
4. The program of the event will be:
 - 1900 Signing on opens.
 - 1945 Signing on Closes. Competitors briefing.
 - 2001 Start time of Car 1.
 - 2210 Approx finish time of Car 1.
5. Cars will start at one minute intervals; Total mileage will be approximately 65 miles. The correct route will be deemed to be the shortest route unless otherwise instructed. The majority of the route will be on coloured roads; however, a few short sections of whites at controls will be used. All routes are passable in a standard road car. Latest edition of Ordnance Survey 1:50000 Landranger series map 173 & 174 will be required in their entirety.
6. The event will consist of three classes as follows:
 - Experts** – any crew whose navigator has won 3 or more 12-car rallies or finished in the top 3 on more than 1 higher status road rally.
 - Novices** – any crew (excluding Beginners) whose navigator has won less than 3, 12-cars and has not finished in the top 3, more than once, on a higher status road rally.
 - Beginners** – any crew whose navigator has competed in no more than 9 previous 12-cars, and has not won more than 3 twelve car events.
7. Awards will be presented as follows:
 - 1st Overall Spring Rally Shield. (Awards to be presented at Dolphin Awards Night 2020)
8. The entry list opens on publication of this notification and closes at 12:00 on the 27th March 2019. The maximum number of entries is 12, the minimum is 8.
9. The entry fee for this event is £8.00 for Dolphin club members & £10 to others. Cheques to be made out to The Dolphin Motor Club (Newbury) Ltd., Entries should be sent to Secretary of the Event: Paul Hardy, 7 Henshaw Crescent, Newbury, RG14 6ES. paul.hardy@stfc.ac.uk

Driving Standards Officer(s) - t b a / Event stewards – t.b.a
 - All Officials and named marshals are Judges of Fact on the following items,
 - Failure to comply with Road Book instructions to stop at road junctions.
 - Unauthorised use of auxiliary lights.
 - Sound.
 - Violation of out of bounds areas. (Black spots).



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11. Provisional results will be published as soon after the end of the event as possible. Results will be made final as soon as possible after the provisional results. **THE ORGANISERS DECISION IS FINAL.**

12. Competitors will be supplied with any black spots quiet zones and give ways at signing on.

13. Marking will be as follows.

Not reporting at a TC.	1 Fail.
Not reporting at an MTC.	Exclusion.
Early arrival at any time control.	2 Marks per Minute.
Late arrival at any time control.	1 Mark per Minute.
Opening any sealed envelope containing route information.	30 marks each.
Exceeding 30 minutes accumulative lateness at any TC.	1 Fail each.
Exceeding Makeup.	30 Marks.
Not recording or recording an incorrect code at a PC.	10 Marks.
Recording a dummy PC.	10 Marks.
Entering or leaving any time control in the wrong direction.	1 Fail.
Any of the following.	
oEntering a black spot.	
oNot stopping at a give way or stop junction.	
oNot driving as instructed in a quiet zone.	
oNot taking note of an instruction from an official.	
oExcessive vehicle noise,	
oBreaking national speed limits	
oDriving likely to bring motor sport into disrepute.	Exclusion.

14. Insurance is by the REIS Motor Sports Club Scheme:

The Club have applied to JELF for a Blanket Cover Note under the above scheme. The basic rate for the Event (before any loadings) will be £17.

Competitors must have Insurance in place which provides Third Party Liability cover that complies with the Road Traffic Act. This can be an extension to the existing motor-policy for the car or purchased via the event organisers. If a competitor uses an extension to an existing policy, they will be required to sign a declaration that the cover complies with the requirements of the Road Traffic Act. Any responsibility for a fraudulent or misleading declaration about existing cover lies with the competitor. If a competitor wishes to purchase cover via the organisers, then they can do so prior to the event providing they comply with the following:

Age 19 Years or over

Has held a full licence for a minimum of 6 months

Has no more than 6 points on their Licence

Has no more than 1 fault claim in the last 3 years

Anyone aged less than 19 years old will also be accepted at the same price should their co-driver be a more senior member of their family or over 25. Any competitor, who falls outside these parameters, may be offered cover at the standards price (or a higher price) depending on circumstances. These competitors must ask the event organisers to obtain agreement from JELF prior to the event.
