Regulations

Organisation:

1. Oxford Motor Club will organise the 'Motorsport Valley Scenic Tour' on Sunday September 6th, 2026.
2. Navigation will be via an easy-to-use Tulip Road book, guiding crews along a scenic route that should be enjoyable to both driver and navigator.
3. The event will be held under a certificate of exemption issued by Motorsport UK, these Regulations, and any written instructions given by the organisers.
4. The event has no competitive element.
5. The Motorsport UK Event Permit number is: 208240.

Eligibility:

6. The event is open to any four-wheeled motor car.
7. The event is open to members of the Organising Motor Club, members of other Motor Clubs and the public.

Entries:

8. The entry fee is £40.
9. Entries open on publication of these Regulations, and close on Monday 31st August.
10. All entries must be made using the on-line entry form below:

11. Once you have completed the entry form, please pay the entry fee via Bank transfer:

12. Each entry will be acknowledged by email.
13. The entry fee includes one 'tulip style' Road book, one vehicle identity plate, & tea/coffee at the start. Food is available at the halfway halt and the finish but is not included in the entry fee.
14. The maximum number of cars on the event is 25. The minimum is 15. Should the above minimum figure not be reached, the organiser's reserve the right to cancel the event and entry fees will be refunded in full.
15. Running order will be in year of manufacture but if an entrant particularly wants to run close to another entrant, please note this in the appropriate section of the entry form.
16. If you withdraw before entries close, the entry fee will be refunded in full. After this, the refunded amount will be at the organiser's discretion.
17. Notice of withdrawal of an entry must be sent via email to the entries Secretary.

Documentation:

18. Drivers must hold a valid driving licence. A competition licence is not required.
19. All cars must hold a V5C Registration Document, be insured for use on the public highway. It must also have road tax and a valid MOT certificate (where applicable.) The driver will be required to sign a declaration to this effect at documentation.
20. A basic vehicle Scrutineering/Eligibility check may be carried out at the start. Any vehicle, which, in the opinion of the organisers, is deemed inappropriate or unsafe, will not be allowed to start. Cars must not display any advertising or competition numbers.
21. After documentation, entrants will be given their Event Vehicle Identity Plate, Road Book, and Route Check Card.

Route:

22. The event will start at Motorsport UK HQ, Bicester Motion, Bicester OX27 8AL, with a halfway halt at the Cotswold Barn. The finish will be at the Kingsley Café, Eynsham, Witney OX29 4EF.
23. The route will cover approximately 85 miles in South Northamptonshire and West Oxfordshire.
24. The route will be given in an easy-to-follow Tulip Style Road Book, which will be issued to entrants at the start of the event.
25. Fuel will be available along the route. This will be detailed in the finals/road book.
26. Along the route, there will be Check Points to observe the entrant's adherence to the defined route. At each point the entrant's Route Check Card will be signed. These Check Points will be open for specified periods, giving adequate time to visit them while they are open.
27. Although not required to complete the route, entrants may like to follow their progress on Ordnance Survey 'Landranger' maps 151, 152, and 164.

Timetable:

28. The timetable for the event will be as follows:
 - Monday 31st August. Entries close
 - Wednesday 2nd September. Final Instructions sent via email
 - Sunday 6th September. **09:00** Signing on & documentation opens
 - 09:45** Drivers Briefing
 - 10:00** First car starts
 - 11:30** Approximate time of first car arriving at Cotswold Barn
 - 12:15** First car leaves Cotswold Barn
 - 13.30** Approximate time of first car arriving at the Kingsley Cafe

Driving Standards:

29. This is a non-competitive event so please drive sensibly and abide by the highway code at all times. Whilst the organisers have tried to ensure that the route avoids built up areas as much as possible, you will pass through a number of small villages. Please drive sensibly through these villages. Driving Standards Officers may be observing in some of these locations.
